Activity Description:



Provide buttons for children to thread onto the tree, this promotes fine motor skills and hand to eye co-ordination, talk about the colours of the leaves on the tree and the colours of the leaves outside especially in the autumn. This could also be adapted around Christmas time to make Christmas trees with baubles on. Count out the number of buttons that can fit on 1 branch but ask the children to predict how many they think can go on to start with. Use different shaped buttons too.
