## Ten green bottles

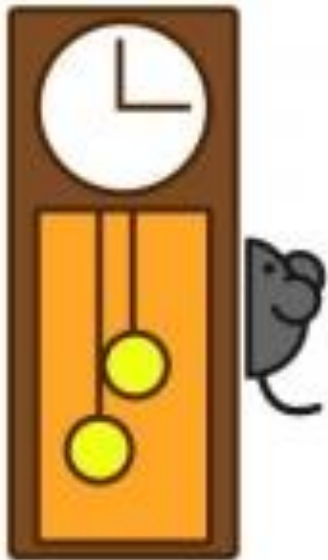
Ten green bottles sitting on the wall,

Hickory Dickory Dock

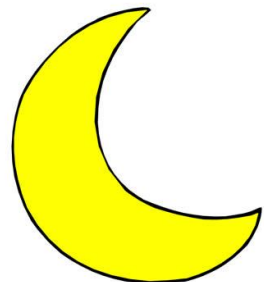

And the dish ran away with the spoon!





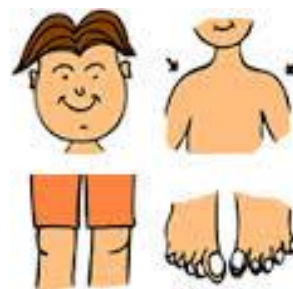
## Wind the bobbin up

(Repeat, getting faster each time)

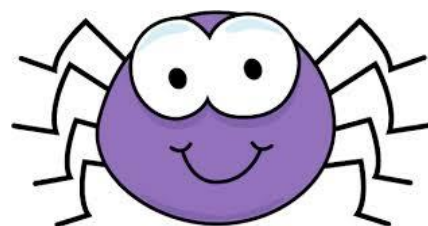


## I Hear Thunder

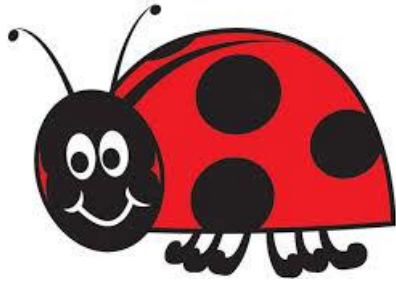
I hear thunder, I hear thunder

"I'll be back in the morning yes I will, will, will."



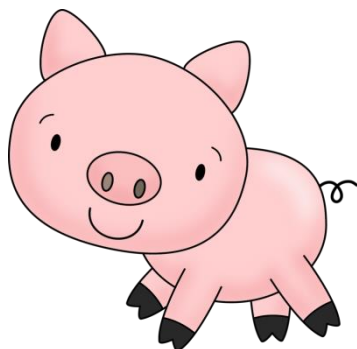
## Round and Round the Garden

Because he can't work any faster.

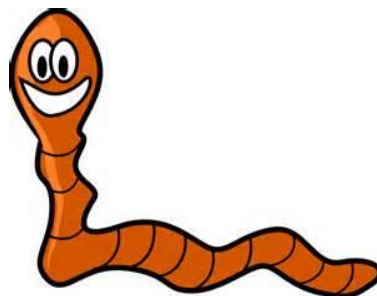


# This Little Piggy

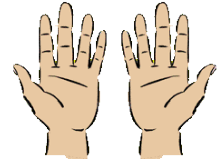


**(“Now it's Toby Tall which is your middle finger; he's the tallest one of them all”)**
