What we want our Preschool Children to have the opportunity to be able to do......

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Making relationships- To build good relationships with adults and peers and to be able to turn take and express their needs. Be respectful of resources and each other.

Sense of self- To be aware of their own interests, be resilient to new experiences.

Understanding emotions- To understand their emotions and self-regulate. Ask an adult for help or assistance.

Communication & Language

Listening & Attention- To be able to sit for a group story and raise their hand for attention, be able to wait for a turn.

Understanding- To know the routine of the day, follow and carry out 3 step instructions. Know where things belong and help tidy away.

Speaking- To know songs, rhymes, rhyming words, some phonics, to be able to retell a story in the correct sequence and to be polite and use respectful language.

Physical Development

Moving & Handling- To use gross and fine motor skills in an controlled manner.

Health & Selfcare- To be completely independent in toileting, dressing and hand washing, have a knowledge of healthy living.

Literacy

Reading- Retell a story in chronological order & answer questions regarding the story, recognise their name, some phonics and know some rhyming words, songs, and rhymes.

Writing- To be able to write their name and mark make with a purpose.

Mathematics

To recognise and understand the value of numbers to 10, subsides to 6, know some 2D & 3D shapes, capacity, volume and other mathematical terms.

Understanding the world

People and Communities- To be aware of the local environment and share experiences.

Technology- To be aware if simple devices.

The World- To understanding of their place in the world and universe, Knowledge of a variety of celebrations from different cultures.

Expressive Arts and Design

Creating with materials- To be able to use a variety of materials and tools independently.

Being Imaginative & Expressive- To be able to role play & retell a story form their gained experiences.
