

What we want our Toddlers to be able to do.....

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Making relationships-Build relationships with familiar people to support confidence in initiating play.

Sense of self- Explore themselves as a unique child, through own identities, name, favourite colour, and difference in interest.

Understanding emotions- Understand emotions and feelings. Identify them on flashcards.

Communication & Language

Listening & Attention- Increase attention and focus when listening to stories or song time in small groups.

Understanding- Identify structure of routine through visual timeline.

Speaking- Match words to gestures and expressions to support clear communication.

Physical Development

Moving & Handling- Show confidence in securing control in gross motor skills.

Health & Selfcare- To be fully toilet trained and confident in basic dressing and undressing.



Literacy

Reading- To share experiences with favourite books, join in with actions and phrases.

Writing- To mark make with intent.

Mathematics

To recognise simple shapes and colours

Understanding the world

People & Communities- Use own life experience to connect their imaginary play.

Technology- Build a basic knowledge around operating cause and effect equipment and toys.

The World- To notice detailed features in the environment.

Expressive Arts & Design

Creating with material- To be able to use tools for specific purpose.

Being imaginative & Expressive- Roleplay on imaginative world through exaggerated expression and sound.
